The School

We will:

- encourage children to do their best at all times
- contact parents/carers if there is a problem with attendance or punctuality
- provide a safe, secure and stimulating learning environment
- provide a balanced curriculum and endeavour to meet the individual needs of the child
- work in partnership with parents/carers about any concerns or problems that affect their child's work or behaviours
- set and monitor homework appropriate to each child's age and ability
- send home an annual report and arrange Parent Evenings to discuss progress and set targets
- keep parents/carers informed about the children's curriculum
- keep parents/carers informed about school and community activities through weekly newsletters
- celebrate and share children's personal achievements and successes

The Child

I will:

- always try my best and begin to take responsibility for my own learning, including my homework
- work hard to achieve my targets and bring to school everything that I need for the day
- show honesty and respect to other children and adults
- behave well and observe school and classroom rules at all times
- inform an adult in school if I'm worried about anything

The Parent/Carer

I/We will:

- Ensure that my/our child goes to school regularly exceeding 96% attendance each year
- ensure that my/our child arrives on time, (8:50am) properly equipped and wearing the required school uniform
- let the school know of any absence by 9.20am on the morning of absence
- let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my/our child's work or behaviour
- support the school in maintaining high standards of behaviour
- support my/our child with his or her homework and other opportunities for home learning
- attend Parent Evenings and discussions about my/our child's progress and attendance
- ensure the school knows of any change of contact details
- support the school where possible with trips, workshops and PTA activities
- ensure that due consideration is given to other drivers and children's safety at the beginning and end of the school day
