There will be a prize for the winning entry from each primary school in Chippenham. Each winner will get a £25 book voucher and have their design made into a wooden sculpture, which will form part of the woodland sculpture trail that will be developed over the next year.

In addition, there will also be an overall winner chosen from the individual winners from each school who will win £500 in book vouchers for their school.

So, not only can you have the winning entry from your school, but you can also gain a prize for your school too!

How to enter?

It couldn't be simpler to take part. Just draw a picture of an animal or bird that you think would make a great sculpture to feature in our woodland trail. It would be great if it was a creature that you might find in the UK or perhaps you have ideas for a fantasy creature that would feel right at home in our woodland at Westmead Open Space.

Once your masterpiece is complete, write your name, age and school you attend on the back and choose one of the options below to get your picture back to us. You can:

1. Send a photo of your entry to katie@cblc.org.uk with details of your name, age and the school you attend.
2. Post or drop off your entry to Katie Bradbury, Communications Officer, Chippenham Borough Lands Charity, Jubilee Building, 32 Market Place, Chippenham, Wiltshire, SN15 3HP. Make sure to write your name, age and the school you attend on the back.
3. Alternatively, you could give your design to your school reception for us to collect shortly after the closing date.

It must reach us or your school by Friday 7th June 2019. We will be sharing the entries that we receive directly to us here at CBLC on our social media and website - cblc.org.uk. If you fancy being 'published' send your entry directly to us.

The prizes!
