Dear parents/carers,

During last term year 6 have taken the SATs tests – a sequence of tests in English (reading, grammar, punctuation and spelling) and mathematics (arithmetic and reasoning). Similarly, year two children will have taken SATs papers in reading and mathematics during the May.

The outcomes of the tests, together with the detailed and rigorous assessments that teachers make and share with you at parent's evenings are celebrations of the progress that your child makes throughout their time at Brompton Westbrook. As governors, we also look forward to receiving the school results later in the year since these give a comparison of our performance against other schools nationally.

The team at Brompton Westbrook are dedicated and committed professionals. They always give their best so that your child achieves well and progresses in their learning.
