**NURSERY** Otter class have been learning and singing the counting rhyme 5 Little Ducks. The children are going to take part in PE every Wednesday morning in preparation for sports day. Please can your child bring a PE kit, (trainers, shorts and T shirt) to get changed into.

**YEAR 1/2** This week we kicked off our Minibeast topic with some exciting bug hunts. The children enjoyed these rather too well and we now have several 'pet' ladybirds who seem to mysteriously appear in our maths lesson after morning playtime. We learnt to classify different bugs according to the number of legs/wings and body parts. In maths the Year 2 children have been partitioning 3 digit numbers and the Year 1 children have practiced using number bonds to 10 and 20. Next week Year 1 children will take their phonics screening check with me. This only takes around 15 minutes to complete and is based on the sounds your child has learned to read during the year.

**RECEPTION** This week we have been reading the story of the Jack and the Beanstalk. We have planted our own beanstalks and are hoping they will start to grow soon. Please can you make sure your child has a PE Kit in school every Wednesday including trainers as we are practicing for sports day.

**YEAR 5/6** The weeks are flying by fast in Gorilla class. We have started to look at our novel for the half term, 'Oliver' by Charles Dickens. We've had some great play scripts produced, and are beginning to practice our end of term production. We're just starting the cast list, and the children are keen for the big parts!

In maths, we have been looking at sequences and algebra. The focus is on transition activities for high school.

Year 6s have started their second stint of forest schools.
