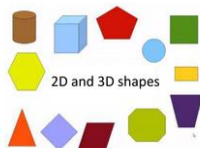
Sealing the lid:

- 24 hr clock



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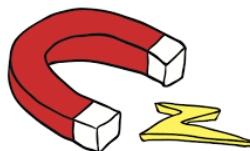
Mass and capacity
