Week 1 Art	Cut out letters from a magazine and create your name, in the style of Surrealism.	Explain in sentences what you know about Salvador Dali.	Draw a self-portrait or a portrait of an animal (pet) in the style of a surrealist artist.	Choose a different Artist e.g. Rene Magritte and explain in detail how their work is different to Salvador Dali.	Look at famous painting by Salvador Dali and write a conversation between you and one of the characters.	Find a favourite Surreal painting, and write a description of why it is your favourite.
Week 2 Literacy	Write a fact file about David Walliams.	What does SURREAL mean? Use a dictionary or thesaurus to find out as many vocabulary words as possible.	Make a story board, or write a detailed review of Mr Stink.	Create 2 character descriptions from Mr Stink and compare the characters.	Create a new character for the story of Mr Stink. Think about how they can fit into to the story.	Write a positive review for Mr Stink and explain why it should be read by others.
Week 3 Science	Find out about high and low friction objects at home.	Explain how a parachute opens.	Explain why friction is important to us.	Make a parachute using objects you find at home.	Invent a new type of footwear for gripping different surfaces.	Which objects have good or bad friction? Explain.
Week 4 Sport	Tell us the main rules of Sports week at school	Explain why it is important for humans to stay fit and healthy	Create a model of Rivelin playing field in sports week.	Write and compare different types of athletics we will do in Sports week.	What is your favourite sport? Create a fact-file of your favourite to include rules, and tactics.	Explain how you feel about sports, in school and out of school. Which sports person do you look up to the most and why?
Week 5 Maths	Choose a famous surrealist painter and find out the amount their paintings have been sold for.	Calculate the number of lines of symmetry in the shapes of a famous Surrealist painting.	Rank the places where surrealism happened in order of size and population.	Plot on a bar chart the amount of pictures different surrealist artists produced.	Create your own version of a surrealist picture and work out the area and perimeter of your picture.	Create a 3D surrealist sculpture by measuring each material accurately. Explain which materials you used and why.
Week 6 Art	Cut out different images and create you very own Surrealist painting.	Explain what Surrealism is and why it is a popular art movement	Research optical illusions on the internet, or in books. Write about why you think they might be described as surreal	Choose an interesting painting from an artist of your choice. Explain what is in the painting, and what it makes you feel. Is there a metaphor, or hidden meaning in the painting? What is it?	Pick a painting in the Surrealist style, and re-create it on your own.	Write about what you have enjoyed during this topic, and what you have learned? Is there anything else you would like to find out?
