A pupil's scaled score is based on their raw score. The raw score is the total number of marks achieved in a test, based on the number of questions answered correctly. The raw score is then converted into a scaled score.

The scaled scores range from 80 – 120. A pupil achieving a scaled score of 100 or more is deemed to have met the expected standard for that test. A pupil achieving a scaled score of 110 or more is deemed to be achieving at a higher standard.
