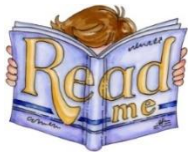


In English we will be learning to...

- Read accurately words of two or more syllables
- Read non-fiction books that are structured in different ways
- Learn the possessive apostrophe (singular) [for example, the girl's book]
- Continue to use the diagonal and horizontal strokes used to join letters
- Write narratives about personal experiences and those of others
- Learn how to use sentences with different forms: statement, question, exclamation, command



In Science we will be learning to...

- Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses
- Find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching

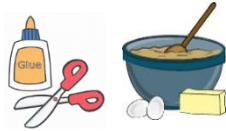
In Maths we will be learning to...

- Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use $<$, $>$ and $=$ signs
- Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100
- Recognise and use the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction and use this to check calculations and solve missing number problems
- Recall our 2, 5 and 10 times tables
- Recognise, find, name and write fractions $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$, and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity



What else can I do at home?

- Read your reading book every day and discuss which words tell you how the characters are feeling
- Practise your spellings and sounds
- Practise your number bonds to 20
- Practise your 2, 5 and 10 times tables
- Try the Home/School book 'Challenges'
- Find out about London's 'Monument' and visit it if you can
