In English

This half term we are going to focus our English work around the theme of pirates. We are going to be;

- researching and writing about famous pirates
- writing pirates stories
- creating treasure maps and writing instructions for finding the treasure
- writing letters in a bottle
- writing diaries about life as pirate

We will also be having a particular focus on spelling and handwriting this half term.



What are we learning this term?

In mathematics

The children will be revisiting and consolidating areas of the maths curriculum that they have already been taught this year. The areas covered will include;

- data handling (creating and interpreting picture and bar graphs)
- multiplication and division
- money
- problem solving

This term the children will have 100 club on a Friday morning; a separate information sheet has been included about this. It would be helpful if you could spend some time each week practising for the quizzes with your child.



In other subjects

Science — the children will be learning about animals including habitats, life cycles and food chains with a particular focus on animals that live in our oceans and seas.

Music — the children will be having a weekly singing practise to enable them to learn the songs for this year's Little Brid Sing.

Design & Technology — the children will be designing and sewing some 3D fish and creating 3d model islands. We will also be welcoming Mrs Grant in to school to do some clay work with the children.

Art— we will be creating some under the sea art work as well creating some art work ready for this year's Bishop Wilton Show art classes.

Computing—we have recently renewed our subscription to PurpleMash and your child will be receiving a unique password which will enable them to logon at home as well as school. This online platform is a fantastic resource allowing the children to complete a wide range of tasks including computer generated art, information posters and simple computer programming.
