## Attendance

As a Local Authority School we are required to monitor attendance and set targets to improve the attendance of all our pupils. Any absences will impact on your child's learning. For children to make the best possible progress it is vital that they attend School, on time, every day unless the reason for the absence is unavoidable.

Good attendance means being in School at least 95% of the time.

Certificates for good attendance are displayed in the Cloakroom each week.



## School Fund

The children's Nursery Education is funded by the Government but this does not include money to provide the children with a present at Christmas and Easter, some additional visitors to school, parties and treats. To be able to fund this we have a School Fund which we ask all parents to contribute to. We ask for a contribution of £10 per term, which is collected through our Parent Pay system. I would like to thank you in advance for all of the contributions you make.

## School Leavers 2019

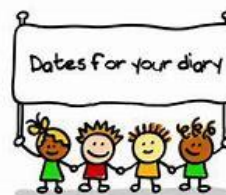
