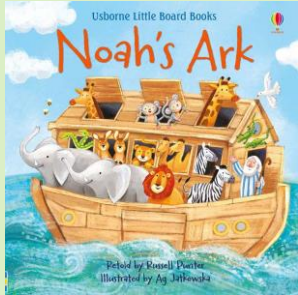


Reception Summer 2019

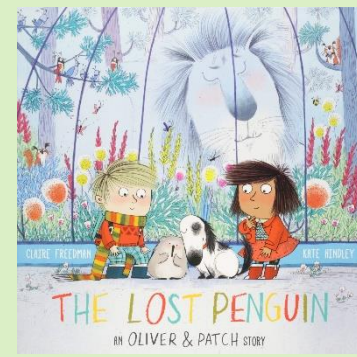
Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- To persevere and never give up!
- The confidence to try new tasks.
- Understand which behaviours are and aren't acceptable.
- To adjust behaviour to different situations.
- Play co-operatively.
- Show sensitivity to other people.



Communication and Language

- To listen attentively in a range of situations.
- To listen to stories and respond with comments.
- To carry out instructions which contain several parts.
- To express ourselves effectively, showing awareness of the listener's needs.
- To develop our own narratives and explanations.



Physical Development

- Show good control and co-ordination in large and small movements.
- Move confidently in a range of ways.
- Handle equipment effectively, including pencils for writing.
- Understand the importance of exercise and staying healthy.

Literacy

- Key Texts: Noah's Ark, The Lost Penguin.
- Re-tell stories using repeated story language.
- Talk to others about what they have read, demonstrating their understanding of the text.
- Letters and Sounds: phase 3 and phase 4
- Write captions and sentences using their knowledge of letters and sounds.
- To write narratives using our Talk for Writing skills!

Mathematics

- Estimate and count accurately
- Add objects and find how many altogether by counting on
- Solve problems including doubling and sharing.
- Describe position and direction e.g. Over, under, behind, on top, next to,
- Measure height and weight using appropriate vocabulary to describe them
- Use mathematical language to describe and name 2D and 3D shapes.
- Solve problems, counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Understanding of the World

- Family Traditions – what did you do in the half term?
- God's creations – what do these stories teach us?
- To understand different beliefs and points of view and know that we are all equally important and special.
- Recognise features of our environment.
- Make observations of animals and plants.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Investigate a variety of materials, tools and techniques.
- Sing songs and make music!
- Represent our own ideas through art, technology, music, stories and role play.



Things you can do at home:

- Create a story without using a book. Everyone in the family could take turns at adding the next part of the story a part!
- Talk about your family traditions and celebrations, how do you celebrate?
- Visit some animals at your local park/pond/farm/zoo. Why are animals special to our world?
- Read lots of stories and practise re-telling them using actions!
- Explore the idea that Maths is everywhere! How much money do we have left to spend at the shop?
