D-Day 75

Across the school and nursery this week we have been discussing D-Day 75 events with the children and what this means. We have held assemblies for the children discussing respect and how we are respecting the bravery shown by veterans by remembering events from the past and how it is important to learn from them.

The school council were taken out of school to watch the 'We knew Something Was Happening' re-enactment march on Thursday morning. They then reported back to their classes about what they saw.

In the nursery the children linked remembering D-Day to the symbol of a poppy and how that helps us to remember.
