


Year 6 Parent Information Letter

Summer Half Term 2



LEARNING FOR THIS HALF TERM:

Summer Production: Rehearsals will begin immediately for our summer show: The Wizard of Oz. Because we are keeping all acting parts to Year 6 children, we will do all of the rehearsals within school time. In previous years, there have been after school rehearsals but this shouldn't be needed.

English: We will complete our writing work within the first three weeks of the half-term. We will be using the Titanic as the stimulus for much of our classroom work. Spellings will not be set anymore.

Science: We will conduct an investigation linked to the Titanic before moving onto our final topic: Animals including Humans.

History & Geography: Linking to our writing, we will be using the Titanic as our focus this half-term. A design technology project will link to this where the children will design and build a mini replica of the ship.

P.E.: P.E. lessons will be more frequent this half-term if the weather stays good. Please encourage your child to keep their outdoor kit in school during the week – especially their trainers. Please keep sun cream in your child's bag and advise them to apply this regularly on hot days.

Foreign Languages: Children will be introduced to the simple future tense. They will act as imaginary fortune-tellers to predict their own as well as their peers' futures. We will spend the final weeks of the year learning some basic Spanish in readiness for Year 7.
