Dear Parent/Carer

As you are aware, the children in Key Stage 1 are to visit Cleethorpes on the following dates:

Year 1 – Thursday, 20th June 2019

Year 2 – Thursday, 27th June 2019



On the day of your child's visit:

- Children will need to be in school for **8.15am through their cloakroom doors** as we will be leaving school by **8.30am prompt** and any late comers will be left behind.
- Please **apply sun cream** at home even if it is not red hot, as we will be outside all day. We are planning to take a large bottle of Factor 50 sun cream with us so that if we feel that it is necessary we can apply this to hands and faces. We assume to have **your permission** to do so but if you have any issues with this (such as allergies), please speak to the class teacher before the day of the visit.
- Children should **dress suitably for the weather on that day**. They must wear their school t-shirt /gingham dress but are allowed to wear shorts/joggers/leggings etc. so they are comfortable. Shorts are ideal for paddling in if the weather is going to be nice. Comfortable **trainers** are advisable and a **rain coat/jacket** again weather dependent. A **sun hat** with name in as well please.
- You must send a **packed lunch** unless you have pre-ordered a grab a bag as the kitchen will not be supplying any spares. Send an **extra drink** as well in a container that can keep being sipped from.

- Children will need a **draw string/rucksack type bag** as they will need to carry their own things including their lunch, as we will be walking around a lot. We suggest you pack some **spare clothes** (definitely spare shorts/trousers or similar) for when we have finished on the beach. A hand towel would also be useful.



- If they are happy to carry it, they may bring a **beach item** such as a small bucket or spade to share and play with their friends.



- Travel sickness or other **medication** required should be labelled and handed to the class teacher with a medical form, which can be obtained from the office.



- Spending money **IS NOT** required and phones will not be allowed on the visit.



We expect to **arrive back at school at approximately 4.00pm** but this will obviously depend on the traffic – please be prepared that it could be later. Children will be dismissed through their cloakroom doors (not from the coach) so you should wait on the playground to collect them.

Please be reminded that your child cannot take part in the visit without your signed consent. If you have not yet returned a completed **Visit Information Form** please collect another and return it straight away.
