Please ensure that 48 hours has elapsed after any episode of diarrhoea or vomiting before your child returns to school. A note or e-mail should be sent in to school once your child returns. School staff will contact parents / carers if we have not been notified, so that registers may be marked correctly. We ask that wherever possible, appointments are not made during school time. If not possible, please send your child's letter or appointment card in to school in advance.
