Up-coming news and events for the week ahead

"Wet Fun Day": The school council have organised a "Wet Fun Day" for tomorrow school on Friday 14th June. This will include a wet obstacle course and a "slip & slide" mat. The school council ask for a minimum donation of £1.00 per child to take part with all proceeds going towards school funds. Children are asked to come to school dressed in old clothes (prepared to get wet) and to bring a change of clothes, footwear and a towel.

P1 - P4 will take part from 1pm-2pm

P5 - P7 will take part from 11am - 12pm (P5 - P7 will be responsible for drying & changing themselves)

AS STAFF CANNOT CHANGE CHILDREN we would ask that parents of children in P1 - P4 come to the field at 1.45pm to collect them. We have very limited changing facilities so WHERE POSSIBLE children should go home to be changed. P1 - P4 bus pupils will be helped to dry off before going home on the bus but cannot be fully changed.
