VE Day, or Victory in Europe Day, marks the day towards the end of World War Two when fighting came to an end in Europe.

The holiday will form part of a three-day weekend of commemorative events. They will include more than 20,000 pubs encouraging people to toast the heroes of the war, while churches will take part in a Ringing Out For Peace.


Silent Promise Auction:
