You may wish to bring something to sit on as there is very little seating around the area.

For health and safety reasons all spectators are asked to remain outside the fenced area of the Athletics track for the duration of the event.

All our competitors will have the opportunity to take part in at least four events i.e. running, long jump, throwing the 'howler' and 'target hoops'. Following the first round of activities the athletes with the fastest running time, furthest jump, longest throw and most accurate throw in each of the five houses will then represent their team in the various Marlborough Sports Finals where the first three places will be awarded Gold, Silver and Bronze medals. These will be presented at a special assembly.

On the reverse is a map of the track and the times and locations where each year group will be competing in the various events. Please note all times are approximate.
