FEELING GOOD WEEK

We will be celebrating National Feeling Good Week this year 17th -21st June.

Mental health problems affect 1 in 10 children, this can include depression, anxiety and conduct disorders. Having good mental health is as important as having good physical health. This helps children to develop resilience and gives them the emotional tools they need to cope with everyday upsets and life events. Feeling valued, accepting others, eating a balanced diet, taking part in physical activity and being able to cope with tricky situations are just a few important skills that have a positive impact on emotional well-being. Feeling Good week has been developed to support children to develop these skills.

This year's theme is '**Together we can**' – it is encouraging children to work together as a team, build relationships and share their feelings. We have planned a range of activities for the week to support children to work together to achieve goals; improve listening, learning, sharing and trust; help children to develop respect and pride in shared activities; build positive relationships, an awareness of both themselves and others; understand their

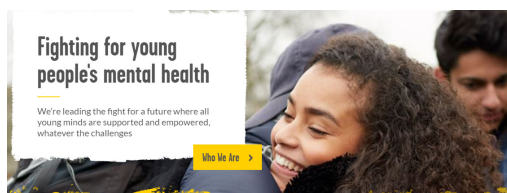


own and others attitudes and values and promote equality and community cohesion.
