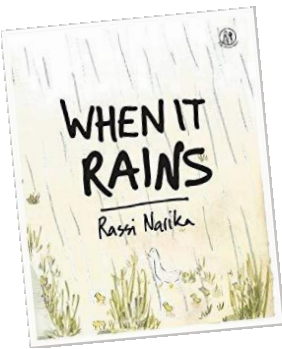
Burwell House
