Year 1 go ape!

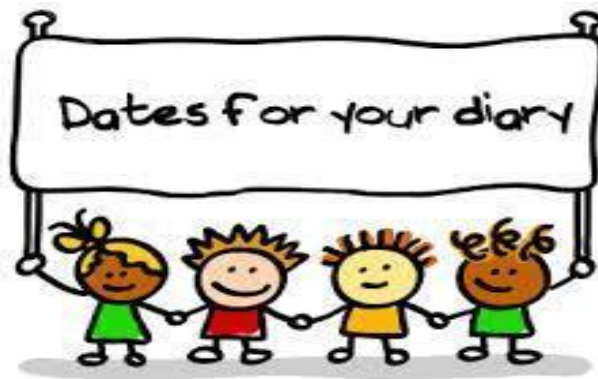
