Safer Cycling Scheme

Please find below information regarding Safer Cycling which takes place from **Monday 1st July- Thursday, 4th July**. The Safer Cycling Team is organised by Road Safety Officers from Trafford. Children will be split into two groups; one Monday/Tuesday all day and one Wednesday/Thursday all day. Children who are attending secondary school transition at Ashton-On-Mersey, Sale High, Altrincham Girls' Grammar, Altrincham College, North Cestrian or Stretford Grammar will be in Group A with the remainder of children in Group B.

Session 1	Mon 1 st July	A – 9.30– 11.30am	A – 1.00 – 3.00pm
Session 2	Tues 2 nd July	A – 9.30– 11.30am	A – 1.00 – 3.00pm
Session 3	Wed 3 rd July	B – 9.30– 11.30am	B – 1.00 – 3.00pm
Session 4	Thurs 4 th July	B – 9.30– 11.30am	B – 1.00 – 3.00pm

- Children can bring trousers (not jeans) to be changed into during cycling training.
- Training takes place in all weathers! Warm waterproof clothing / gloves and necessary medication i.e. inhalers are also required..
- Trainees **MUST** have and wear their own cycle helmet.
- Trainees must have a completed consent/bike check form before the commencement of the on road session, failure to supply this will mean exclusion from the course. (To be sent out this week.)
- Trainees **MUST** have a roadworthy cycle and be **able to ride it safely**. A cycle found by the instructor to be unroadworthy / too big or too small on Day 1, session 1, will not be allowed to continue.
- Trainees must successfully complete all four sessions to be awarded a certificate and badge. There is no flexibility to complete missed sessions.
- **No cycling is allowed on the playground, before or after school.**
- During the day, bikes are to be left against the KS2 playground fence (a bike lock will be needed as there are times when the bikes are left unattended).
- Bikes are to be taken home each night as we are unable to store these within school. School are not responsible for any bikes left unattended overnight.
- Please can we ask children to bring lock key on a named keyring so will be easily returned if found.
