Below is an outline of what your child will be learning about:

In this unit your child will revisit their knowledge of male and female bodies. They will learn about external body parts and learn the scientific words for these external parts. They will think more about their bodies' capabilities and uniqueness as we hope to develop the children's positive body image. They will also look at personal hygiene and consider their growing responsibilities for this area, now they are getting older. They will learn more about illnesses which can be spread from one person to another e.g. colds, chickenpox, verruca's and will learn more about how to prevent this.
