Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Welcome back. We have returned in full swing, welcoming the Under Fives' children on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, investigating owls and being involved with the Hindu days on Thursday and Friday.

The week began by looking at the owl facts that the children brought in. We read the story 'Owl Babies' by Martin Waddell. We looked at a selection of different eggs from different animals (chicken, duck and goose), comparing these and cracking them in order to look at the inside of an egg. We also talked about the foods which contain egg and boiled these so that we could compare cooked and uncooked eggs. The children were made aware of not eating eggs uncooked and washing hands after handling eggs. Then we discussed the animals which come from an egg and those which are born as an animal that looks like the parent. The job of the week was to sort animals depending on whether they developed in an egg or as an animal. Very excitedly, we put a number of chicken eggs in the incubator and hope that these will develop and hatch in the next few weeks. The children have painted owls for Nafferton Show and we were lucky enough to obtain some owl pellets which we examined to see what they contain (what they had eaten). The children were fascinated by all of the tiny bones.

The children thoroughly enjoyed the Hindu days with a variety of practical activities. They have been involved in dancing, yoga, learning about the Hindu creation story, making colourful garlands and creating rangoli patterns. We had a fabulous time!
