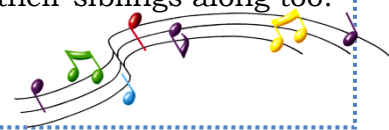

Regular Reminders:

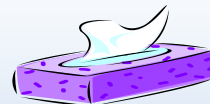
Fruit for snack:
