Visit to Pink Pig Farm – Monday 1 July 2019
Class ES/SC

As part of our topic on farming we will be visiting Pink Pig Farm on Monday 1 July.

We aim to leave school around 9:20 am and return for home-time, to make the most of our day on the farm. The visit will include a tractor and trailer ride, a workshop on bread making. The children will make a bread cake to bring home.

Just like a normal day out with Mum and Dad, the children will be allowed to stroke and feed the animals and play in the play areas. If you have any concerns regarding these activities please do come and see us.

Children need to wear their school uniform tops, a sun hat (if weather appropriate), practical trousers and comfortable shoes. Please ensure they also bring waterproofs, which they can either wear or have in a named bag. We will make a decision about wellies a little nearer the time, so please keep an eye out for a notice on the window. Please ensure all packed lunch items are disposable, including drinks, and placed in a named carrier bag. This way all the lunch stuff can be disposed of after lunch avoiding an additional walk back to the coach.

The total cost of the visit is per child is £21.00 which includes the entry fee and cost of the coach. This is a voluntary contribution and if each pupil agrees to pay, the visit can go ahead. If families who currently receive benefits need assistance with the cost they are asked to contact the school in confidence.
