On Tuesday 25th June the lunch time menu offered to the children will change to the Toy Box Menu. The menu is attached to the newsletter.

If the children prefer, they can choose a jacket potato for lunch or bring in their own packed lunch from home.

Musical Instrument Tuition & Instrument Hire.

Each year we have a healthy uptake for peripatetic instrumental lessons. With the exception of guitar, these lessons are provided by Warwickshire Music and pupils can opt to learn the keyboard, piano, violin, viola, cello, flute, recorder, clarinet or drum-kit, either individually or as part of a group session. Further information, such as the cost of lessons or how to enroll, can be found by visiting www.warwickshiremusic.org. Instruments can also be hired from Warwickshire Music, and are

usually free for the first year. Any pupils currently receiving lessons **also need to re-register for next year** via the Warwickshire Music hub.

Guitar lessons are provided by Independent Music Solutions (IMS), and they can be contacted by emailing admin@independenmusicsolutions.co.uk, or by calling James Suckling (Senior Managing Partner) on 07776 228179. They will be able to provide you with costs and details of how to sign up for guitar.

Please note that instrumental lessons take place during the school day, and we endeavour to avoid pupils missing Maths, English or swimming (Year 3 only), although some lessons may cut across part of lunch time. Once pupils have initially met with their teacher, permanent timetables are printed and displayed on the noticeboard outside the Music Room. Instrumental tuition is the responsibility of the appointed instrumental teacher, but our preference is that **children learn only one instrument in school.**
