

Literacy (including role play /drama)

Underwater adventure stories – The Mermaids Cove, pirate stories and underwater mysteries. Children to develop use of descriptive language to describe an underwater setting and also explore the emotions and feelings of characters (eg Nemo in Finding Nemo).

Shape poetry – a poem with sounds of the sea (onomatopoeia) and including use of alliteration presented in the shape of fish.
