

## Summer term 6 Home Learning “Summer Holiday”



We continue with our termly topic of ‘We’re all going on a summer holiday’ and following on from our wonderful Creative Arts’ Week, our Home Learning topic is looking forward to what we might enjoy doing over the summer months.

This term’s home learning task is to complete a ‘**Summer Holiday**’ project. Ideas could include:

- Plan a dream holiday researching destination, accommodation, travel and places to visit when you are there. You can present this in whatever way you like.
- Design a holiday outfit or even a whole wardrobe!
- Design a holiday resort. This could be a hotel, campsite or holiday park – perhaps you could make a 3D model.
- Design a postcard and write a message to someone.
- Design a poster to promote ‘clean beaches’.
- Think about how to ‘stay safe in the sun’ and present this on a poster or design a PowerPoint.
- Make a list of all the things you need to take on holiday. You will need to think about where you are going and what type of activities you might do while you are away.
- Write a short story titled “My Day Trip”.
- Plan a route for you and your family to complete as many ‘Beat the Street’ boxes as you can. You may want to take photos around the route and explain some of the places you passed along the way. You may even like to complete the route using different forms of transport.

*Important reminders:*

- *Although there is no expectation with quantity, time spent on task or style, **there is an expectation of quality.** We expect books to be looked after, well presented and neat.*
- *This project could be typed (and stuck into books), written by hand or a combination of both.*
- *The project is compulsory for Key Stage 2 pupils and optional for Key Stage 1 pupils.*
