The School Games Mark is a Government led award scheme launched in 2012, facilitated by the Youth Sport Trust to reward schools for their commitment to the development of competition across their school and into the community, and we are delighted to have been recognised for our success.

- * The purchase of durable, all-weather steel football goals (used daily by pupils and for a number of football matches that we were able to host on our fantastic playing fields).

With nearly all children in the school competing in local inter-school competitions and festivals this year, we are extremely proud of our pupils for their dedication to all aspects of school sport, including all the teachers, coaches and parents who made our competitions possible.

As part of our application, we were asked to fulfil criteria in the areas of participation, competition, workforce and clubs, and we are pleased that the hard work of everyone at our school has been rewarded this year.
