### Y6 Bikeability

For the children who have signed up, this begins tomorrow, Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June, lasting for the majority of the day. The second day is next, Friday, 28<sup>th</sup> June.

Children need to arrive prepared with:

- Roadworthy bike
- Helmet
- Appropriate clothing – they will be outside for around 2 hours each day. They may come in clothes other than their school uniform, if they wish.



It is advisable to bring a lock for your child's bike, and bikes can be stored in the garden area, by the greenhouse, before the training begins. Share a lock with a friend if necessary.

Please remember that before and after school, for the safety of all, bikes should not be ridden across the playground.
