Local authorities have the power to fine parents for persistent lateness as well as absence. Our new Education Welfare Officer (EWO) visited the school and checked the late book and will be writing to parents of children who are regularly arriving late to school advising you that if we do not see an immediate improvement then you will be asked to attend a meeting with her. It is disruptive for your child, other children and teachers when your child is late so please do support us with this. There has also been a rise in number of leave requests by the parents during term time. We have been advised that we are not allowed to authorise any leave of absence unless exceptional circumstances such as bereavement.
