Our Celebration worship will be taking place every Friday at 2.45p.m. until the end of this term - due to Year 6 sailing in the morning.

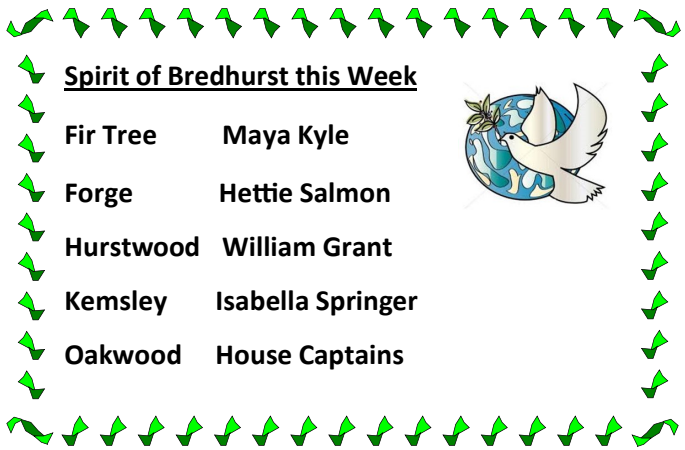
The weather forecast next week is for very hot weather, please make sure the children come into school with: a drink, a hat and have had sun cream applied.
