All complete an evaluation. All reviews take place in the Autumn term identifying the chosen destination. Plans put in place with external agencies i.e travel etc. Students take part in taster days as identified with provider. All students then take part in transition tasters during the summer term often for one day a week to ensure a smooth transition.</p>

Additional information.

We are currently looking at the development of Supported Internships. These will follow on from the students work placements. Students will complete further work experience with support as required for 3 days a week and two days in school completing maths and English.

The students will also complete employability qualification developing interview skills and writing a CV.

The placements will be provided by a bank of suitable employers who are happy to have a student on an Internship programme and have been selected specifically according to the students interests.

These will take place as part of the curriculum for some in the final 3rd year. At the end of the year it is hoped students will be offered a paid job.

St Anne's will also be updating Log on move on web site which is available to all school leavers and parents to access provision available. Staff will be available at the June meeting to help and assist with the use of this provision whilst also providing up to date information on the transition process.
