We will be looking at Scientists and Inventors

The children will learn to:

- Identify different types of evidence
- Explain whether evidence supports or refutes ideas
- Explain their own theories and ideas

English

This term we will be looking at a variety of genres such as personal recounts, non-chronological reports and information texts, including:

- Exploring the story 'Romulus and Remus'
- Looking at, evaluating, and writing our own personal recount
- Evaluating and editing learning, assessing effectiveness of writing

Maths

This term children will be learning decimals and money. The children will learn to:

- Read and write decimal numbers as fractions
- Read, write, order and compare numbers with up to 3 decimal places
- Solve measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals
- Solve problems which require knowing percentage and decimal equivalents

RE

The children will explore Hinduism

They will think about:

- Where and how Hinduism was founded
- Demonstrate an understanding of the different holy books
- The main Hindu festivals
- What it is like to live in Britain today as a Hindu

Topic

This term our topic is City to Coast

The children will learn;

- To use maps, atlases and globes to locate countries, cities and coasts and describe their features
- To use the 8 points of a compass, 4 and 6-figure grid references
- To locate, describe and name UK cities
