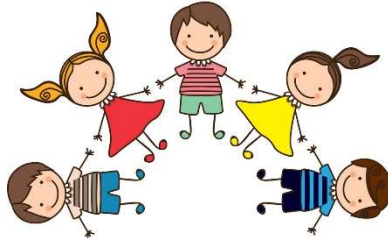


PTA
