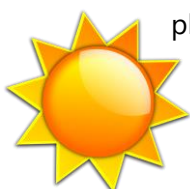

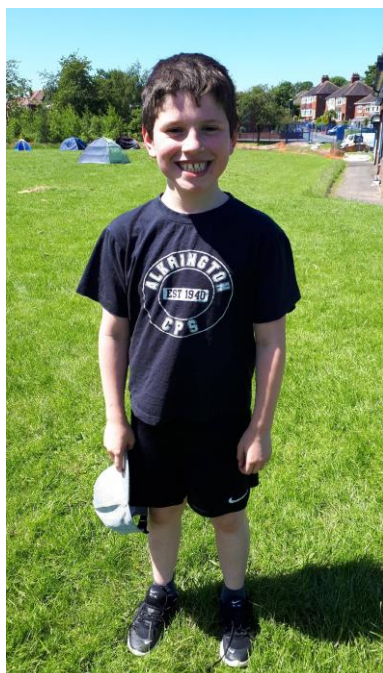
This is due to a Government decision to move the holiday to commemorate VE Day.
