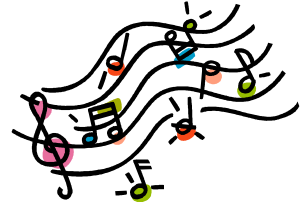




Driffield Junior School

Dear Parents/Carers

We can offer a small number of children the opportunity to learn to play an instrument through the Schools' Music Service. Tuition is given by visiting instrumental teachers and most lessons take place during the normal school day. See attached sheet for details of instrumental lessons available in each year group. Lessons will start in September.

Charges for the small group lessons are **£58** per term with a minimum of 30 lessons being received during the full academic year. Compared to individual private tuition, this still represents good value for money. Most instruments are hired from the Schools' Music Service at £20 per term. Violins are hired from School at £10 per term. Parents are responsible for maintenance and insurance cover.

If a child decides to terminate lessons, written notice is required and refunds for the current term cannot be given. If your child is, or has been in the past, entitled to free school meals, we are able to offer funding through pupil premium to cover the costs of lessons.

This can be an exciting and richly rewarding experience but it does demand from the child, the parents and the tutor a great deal of effort, patience and commitment. Instruments need to be brought into school each week for the lesson and taken home so pupils can practise regularly. If you are interested in this offer and can give your child the necessary continuous support, please complete the attached form and return it to me via the school office by **Friday 5th July**.

Your child will be given a musical awareness test and his/her size assessed as to suitability for the chosen instrument either before the holidays or during the first week or so in September. I will inform you by **Friday 20th September** whether your child was either successful or unsuccessful.

Please note that if your child is chosen (s)he will be asked to join the school orchestra (not guitar) once it is considered that (s)he has achieved the required standard.

	Brass (Cornet, Euphonium, French Horn, Trombone)	3 and 4	Instruments can be hired from the Schools' Music Service (£20 a term).
	Cello	3 and 4	Instruments can be hired from the Schools' Music Service (£20 a term).
	Guitar	3 and 4	Pupils will need to buy their own guitar, if successful. There may be an opportunity to hire one from school. Please ask.
	Percussion (Drum kit plus)	4	Pupils will need to buy a Pack, which includes practice pad, CD and tutor book (approx. £25).
	Violin/Viola	3 and 4	Instruments can be hired from School (£10 a term)
	Woodwind (Flute, Oboe, Clarinet)	3 and 4	Instruments can be hired from the Schools' Music Service (£20 a term).

A child may audition for more than one instrument but is only allowed to receive lessons in one instrument so, if successful in more than one, they will have to choose which instrument to accept. Teachers will choose which brass/woodwind instrument is suitable for the child.

Children receiving lessons this year will receive a letter and Music Agreement form shortly to enable them to continue with the same instrument, unless school is notified in writing that they wish to terminate lessons.
