YEAR 6 FIVER CHALLENGE SALE



Year 6 are taking part in the Fiver Challenge. Each child has worked in a small group to set up a business which has been funded with £5 per person. The children have been challenged to make their money grow. On Thursday, 4 July, the children will be holding a sale to sell the products they have made. Children across the school will be invited to the sale during the day. A range of products will be on sale from stress balls to mini black boards, biscuits to magic wands. Most products will be priced at approximately £1, but will range from 40p to £3.50. Reception children will be invited to visit the sale with their parents after their Summer Performance. We would suggest that the children bring a maximum of £5 to spend at the sale. The profit from the

sale will go to Great Ormond Street Hospital.

IS THIS YOUR CAR?
