Dear Parents/Carers,

School Access Changes

I am writing to inform you of our exciting premises project this summer. We will be building an extension to our Pine and Willow classrooms! This will double the size of the unit and offer an excellent learning space for our younger children. Due to the size of the build, the excavation for ground works will have to begin prior to the summer holidays starting, so it can be completed by September.

As a result, we are having to make some short term changes to the access of the school for the safety of the children and yourselves.

The adventure playground will be closed for the last two weeks of term and there will be no access to the school from Old Church Road. Access to the school will be from the gate on Moorland Street road and the gate near Oak class only. Once in the playground area you will still be able to walk your child to every classroom. Access from Busy Bees to the school will also be closed and we ask that you walk down Moorland Street instead to access the grounds.

This arrangement will begin on Friday 5th July at pick up time.

- PTA cake sales will be in the pergola near the main entrance to the school rather than by the adventure playground during this time.
- Children who attend Forest School club will need to be collected from the main entrance to the school instead of by the outside classroom.
- The Walking Bus will still continue but will take an alternative route to school. The children will walk from the Bus Stop to the Chemist and down Moorland Street to school.

During this time alternative parking can be found by the town play area for free or Meadow Street car park is also free. Any other changes or additional information will be shared with you, if and when necessary.

We appreciate your support and patience during this exciting, but busy, time.
