


We'll Meet Again

Learning Across the Curriculum

English: We will be reading the text Goodnight Mister Tom. This text will be used to inspire a variety of writing outcomes. We will also be focusing on our comprehension skills and knowledge of spelling, punctuation and grammar for our SATs.

Mathematics: Within this term we will be focusing on fractions, decimal, percentages and ratio and proportion. We will develop our mathematical vocabulary based around these concepts by focusing on problem solving and reasoning.

Science: We will be focusing on Light and Electricity. We will carry out tests, observe and generate our own questions around this focus.

R.E: We will be focusing on the themes of People of God and Salvation.

Art and DT: During Art lessons we will be creating art work inspired by the Blitz. In DT we will construct gas mask boxes.

P.E: We are focusing on Invasion Games within our sessions this term.
