This term at school we are going to enrich the learning with:

Learning Across the Curriculum

English: We will be reading the text *The London Eye Mystery*. This text will be used to inspire a variety of writing outcomes.

Mathematics: Within this term we will be focusing on problem solving and reasoning. We will also be applying our learning to investigations.

Science: We will be focusing on Electricity and Classifying Living Things. We will carry out tests, observe and generate our own questions around this focus.

R.E: We will be focusing on the themes of Judaism and Islam.

Art and DT: During Art and DT lessons we will be creating sculptures work inspired by London landmarks.

P.E: We are focusing on striking and fielding games within our sessions this term.

Music: We will be learning songs about London.
