9.30am – Mrs Hall will be at Beningbrough Hall's main car park to receive all the children who are being individually dropped off. Parents/carers are to personally hand over the child(ren) to Mrs Hall so 100% accurate Registers can be taken and the children can be corralled into our safe holding area. Pre-ordered packed lunches will be transported to Beningbrough Hall by Mrs Adamson.

2.10pm – Mrs Hall will release children who are being individually picked up from the same location as drop-off. Children will only be released to parents or the alternative named person on your reply slip.

2.10pm – Those walking back to school will set off in their class groups.

Inevitably there will be parents who must change their transport plans for the day. **IT IS ESSENTIAL** that you inform the school of these changes. Mr McClelland will then inform the staff at Beningbrough Hall.

Key Stage 2 Performances
