PUPIL REPORTS

Today you will have received your child's final termly report. You are able to access your report by logging into My Child at School. We believe reports are a motivational tool for children to help them make further progress and provide opportunities for you to become involved in your child's learning. We hope you find this termly report informative and that you enjoy sharing the comments with your child.

Reporting Attainment

Schools are required to report whether your child is on track to meet year group expectations. Reports will use the following statements to indicate attainment for each subject:

Below ARE – Working towards age related expectations

ARE – Working at age related expectations

Above ARE – Working at greater depth within the year group expectations

Behaviour for Learning

All subject areas have been assessed and graded. The following attributes are given as indicators for each grade.

Excellent (E)

A child who:

- Is consistently absorbed in his/her learning
- Is intrinsically motivated
- Perseveres and strives to maximise his/her potential
- Always listens and follows instructions willingly and uses own initiative
- Works collaboratively and independently with enthusiasm at all times
- Independently reflects on learning and extends class work at home

Good (G)

A child who:

- Is usually absorbed in his/her learning
- Is well motivated and perseveres
- Listens to and follows, instructions willingly
- Often works collaboratively and independently with enthusiasm
- Sometimes reflects on learning and extends class work at home independently

Satisfactory (S)

A child who:

- Is developing resilience in his/her learning





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- Can be motivated with encouragement
- Listens and follows instructions
- Works collaboratively and independently in class activities
- Reflects on learning through completing homework satisfactorily

Needs Improvement (NI)

A child who:

- Can be absorbed in his/her learning through constant encouragement
- Is occasionally motivated but needs support to develop perseverance
- Listens and follows instructions with support
- Needs to develop his/her skills in managing distractions to complete tasks
- Occasionally reflects on learning at home through the completion of homework

Phonics

Pupils in Year 1 and some Year 2 pupils will have also received a report to inform you whether your child has passed their phonics screening check.

Key Stage 1 and 2 results

All Year 2 pupils will have received an end of Key Stage 1 report which informs parents of your child's SATs results.

All Year 6 pupils will receive a report which presents your child's SATs results. This will be available on Thursday 11th July once the National data has been released and the school has processed the results.

Year 6 and Nursery Parent Teacher Consultation

There is a parent teacher consultation available on **Thursday 11th July** for **Year 6 and Nursery** parents should you feel that you need to discuss either your child's SATs results or if you have a child in nursery, their nursery progress.
