



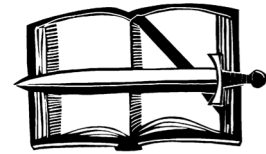

- Next weekend... at the 11.00 am Mass the relic of **St. Edmund Campion** will be here. Saint Edmund Campion, S.J., was an English Catholic Jesuit priest and martyr who was arrested because he was conducting an underground Catholic ministry in officially Anglican England. He was convicted of high treason and brought through Slough and Colnbrook before his cruel execution at Tyburn (present day Marble Arch). St. Edmund Campion was beatified by Pope Leo XIII in 1886 and canonised in 1970 by Pope Paul VI as one of the forty Martyrs of England and Wales. His feast is celebrated on 1<sup>st</sup> December.
