

- 1) Ms Hardman to welcome all to the meeting and ask everyone to share their names again so we can remind ourselves who our eco team are.

Nursery team members: Show – rubbish – including McDs, ask for thoughts on getting people to travel actively to school. Remind of recycling. *The children were shocked at how much McDonalds rubbish there was!*

FS2 and KS1 team members:

- 1) Children help to put together **new eco code** - *The children agreed to get their classes to come up with ideas for our new code.*
- 2) Litter –review school campaign – which classes still have regular monitors? *This was mixed so I asked the reps to make sure their classes were litter picking at break times.*

Ms Hardman to tell children how Rock City not currently recycling cans – need to send posters!

Any volunteers to do posters for McD's and/or rock city? (Be good if they could find out facts to back it up). *Some children agreed to make posters - EWW, AR, OC, EU.*

Share ideas for **Transport** – Active Alderman Pounder travel campaign – carbon “footprint” - diff colourings - *The children said we should just focus on colouring the toes green when an active journey completed as not fair that some children have to come to school by car and so would have to colour theirs in red (or orange if they did park and stride. The children suggested having stickers to say people had travelled actively.*
