Prime Areas

PSED- The children have talked about endangered species and what may cause these sea creatures to become endangered and how that makes the children feel.

Physical- The children have been using the apparatus and moving on and around it using different skills.

Communication and Language- We have talked about what sea creature we would be and why. The children have used all of the facts they have found out so far.

Specific Areas

Literacy- This week the children have been learning some more sea creature facts and writing captions for pictures using adjectives.

Phonics- The children have been re-capping all the sounds and high frequency words learnt so far.

Maths- We have continued to work on subtraction and addition this week. We have used money, cubes and number lines to help us. We have also counted in 2's, 5's and 10's.

Understanding the World- We have been preparing for the trip and talked about different modes of transport, different sights that we may see and what to expect on the trip.
