School Uniform

I have noticed that some children are wearing trainers and items of clothing that are not on the uniform list for example different coloured hoodies, tracksuit bottoms and trainers. Please can I remind you, as you prepare to buy new uniform for September, that trainers are not allowed - children should wear black shoes, only red jumpers or cardigans can be

worn (not hoodies) and grey school trousers or skirts are to be worn not tracksuit bottoms. I appreciate your help with this to keep our children looking smart especially as we move into a brand new school.
