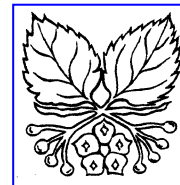

5MH – **Panthers**

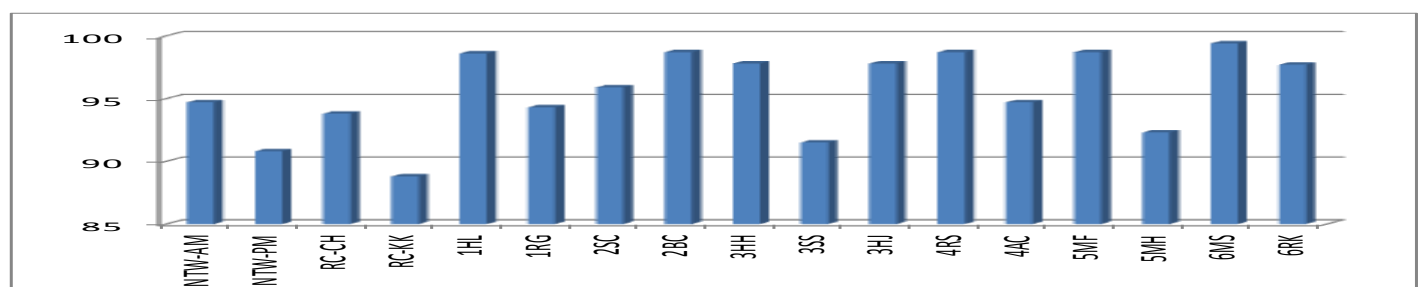
