School Uniform Policy

The policy was approved by the FGB on 9th July 2019

The uniform is gender neutral. We ask for your support in upholding this policy.

AIMS

- Our policy for children's school uniform is based on the belief that a school uniform promotes a sense of pride in the school.
- It supports a feeling of community and belonging.
- It is not distracting in class (as fashion clothes might be) making children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance.
- It is good value for money.

CLOTHING

Our pupils wear school uniform and our school colours are royal blue with white.

The uniform consists of:

- a royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan
- a white polo shirt or shirt
- grey smart trousers, shorts, pinafore, culottes or a skirt, of a reasonable length and not stretchy or tight fitting
- a summer dress either blue or yellow

FOOTWEAR

- Plain black smart shoes (enclosed toes)
- Plain black trainers – no commercial markings or coloured strips allowed. The soles of the trainers or any laces must be black.
- Black boots may be worn. If worn with trousers they should be under not over trousers.

PE UNIFORM

- white short sleeved t-shirt
- blue shorts – loose fitting
- plimsolls or trainers
- tracksuit bottoms (not tight leggings) and a fleece may be worn for outdoor PE **only** (a fleece with the school logo is available for purchase)
- pupils in years 4, 5 and 6 require a single piece swimming costume or trunks (not shorts) one term a year

JEWELLERY/ACCESSORIES

- In the interests of health & safety we ask that children do not wear any jewellery other than:
 - a watch
 - pupils with pierced ears are allowed to wear studs, these must be removed for swimming and for PE they must be removed or covered
- headbands and other hair decorations are welcome as long as they are not large and distract from the learning

If your child is not able to wear the correct uniform for any reason please contact the school office that morning. This will avoid your child being asked about their clothing.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

We would ask that all items of school uniform have your child's name on.

Items embroidered with our school logo can be ordered from the school office. Orders can be made online direct to the company if you wish (www.termtimewear.com) but a carriage charge is applied (full details on the order form). We charge you the same amount that we are charged – there is no mark-up on the school uniform we buy.
